School & Community

The Gladstone Center for Children & Families [GCCF] is a state-of-the-art early childhood facility in Gladstone, Oregon, a small town near Portland. The school serves a diverse population of students attending Gladstone's full-day kindergarten, Head Start preschool and the Gladstone Teaching Preschool. Our small school community allows us to focus on the learning needs of our youngest students. In this warm and joyous environment, teachers get to know each student as an individual, while students have a chance to make friends, explore, and learn.

Weekly Enrichment Classes

Kindergarten students benefit from a whole-child education program with weekly instruction from specialists in:

Positive Behavior Support

Gladstone's kindergarten reinforces a system of positive behavior supports that encourage each student to act respectfully, to work responsibly, and to stay safe. Part of the school's Culture of Care, this teaches students self-management, focus, resiliency, and social-emotional coping skills.
