Gladstone High School Scholarship Application

I. General Information

- A. Purpose: This application will be used to determine an applicant's qualifications for any and all scholarships administered by Gladstone High School.
- B. Eligibility: The applicant must be a graduating senior currently enrolled in Gladstone High School with a minimum GPA of 2.75.
- C. Scholarship Use: The scholarship may be used at a two-year or four-year accredited college or university or an accredited trade school. Some scholarships may be distributed directly to the student and may be used for books, supplies, or room & board.
- D. Selection Criteria: All applicants will be judged on their transcript and this application, as well as individual requirements for specific scholarships (if applicable), including academic achievement, extra-curricular activities, community service activities, demonstrated leadership abilities, and career goals.
- E. Process: All applicants must submit this written application to their counselor. Winners will be determined by Gladstone High School's scholarship committee and will be notified at the Senior Assembly.
- F. Application Dates: All applications must be submitted by 8:15 AM May 3rd. **NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** The scholarship committee or other sponsors may wish to interview finalists.
