Admission of International Exchange Students

The district may accept up to four international exchange students each year to attend Gladstone High School without specific Board approval. Additional international exchange students are subject to Board approval. The students will be required to pay the same fees required of resident students.

The superintendent or designee is authorized to process all requests for approval of international exchange programs and enrollment of students.

The district will accept international exchange students from other nations on a J-1 Visa who reside within the district as participants in an international exchange program officially recognized by the Board. International exchange students on a J-1 Visa are not required to pay tuition.

Privately sponsored international exchange students on an F-1 Visa may be enrolled if an adult resident of the district has been given temporary guardianship and the student lives in the home of that guardian. Students on an F-1 Visa are required to pay tuition at the established district rate. F-1 student admission is limited to secondary schools and attendance may not exceed 12 months.

The superintendent shall develop procedures for approving international exchange programs and accepting international exchange students.

International exchange students must comply with immunization requirements set forth in state law. Once admitted, exchange students become subject to all district policies and regulations governing students.
