Student Vehicle Use

Vehicles parked on district property are under the jurisdiction of the district.

The district will regulate vehicles on its properties to ensure orderly parking and use of student vehicles and to prevent dangerous traffic patterns.

The school district assumes no responsibility or liability for the loss, damage, or negligence of vehicles at any time on school property, nor with the unauthorized use of vehicles on school property or during school activities.

Rules and regulations governing the use of student vehicles shall be reasonable and widely circulated.

Responsibility

- 1. All vehicles parked by students at the school must be registered with the school administration;
- 2. No student vehicle will be permitted to leave the school grounds during the hours in which school is in session without the permission of an administrator;
- 3. Local and state traffic laws must be obeyed;
- 4. Unnecessary noise, dangerous driving, and/or misuse of any vehicle will not be tolerated;
- 5. All vehicles must be parked in an appropriate manner in approved and designated areas;
- 6. All vehicles must be properly licensed with the state and currently registered;
- 7. Student drivers must be insured under a motor vehicle liability insurance policy or other satisfactory proof of compliance with the financial responsibility requirements of the state;
- 8. Tickets for violations of rules and regulations will be enforced as outlined in student handbooks;
- 9. Parking privileges may be revoked for failure to follow requirements.

Cars parked on district property are subject to search by school officials and law enforcement personnel working with them as per Board Policy JFG.

Cars parked against the parking pattern, in an unsafe manner, or in non parking areas such as loading zones, students parking in visitor spaces, fire lanes, or any other unauthorized space may be subject to towing and/or citation by the school resource officer or campus monitor.

The district reserves the right to deny or revoke parking privileges.
