PUBLIC PARTICIPATION IN VIRTUAL MEETINGS

1. Members of the public who intend to offer public comment to the Board must sign up and submit public comments via the [public comment google form](#) on the district website by 1:00 pm on the date of the meeting.
2. Members of the public will be called upon during the zoom meeting to read their written statement for up to three minutes. Speakers need to show their first and last name on their zoom identification to be called to read their statement.
3. Prior to beginning any testimony, Individuals must state their first and last name.
4. Statements by members of the public should be concise. Public comments will be limited to three (3) minutes. Longer submissions may be summarized. The Board chair will be the timer. The Board will attempt to call speakers in the order their comments were received.
5. The Board/Committee reserves the right to delay discussion of any item. The Board may move the item to later in the meeting or at a subsequent meeting.
6. Discussion or presentation concerning a published agenda item is limited to its designated place on the agenda.
7. At the discretion of the Chair, comments that are similar to each other in nature may be referred to in the number received and summarized.
8. Speakers may offer objective criticism of school operations and programs but the Board/Committee will not hear complaints concerning specific school personnel or students. Comments of this nature will not be heard. The Chair will direct the visitor to the appropriate means for Board/Committee consideration and disposition of legitimate complaints involving individuals.
9. These procedures will be published on the back of every virtual public meeting agenda.
